This project will allow you to research and share your knowledge of the world governments. The following is a list of guidelines for you to include in your PowerPoint presentation. This list contains the minimum requirements for the project. There should be one slide for each of the following:

- Title page
- Definition of government
- Definition of anarchy
- Why governments formed (1-2 sentences)
- Definition of politics
- THREE slides for EACH of the following governments:
 1. monarchy
 2. theocracy
 3. aristocracy
 4. oligarchy
 5. dictatorship
 6. democracy
 7. republic

The THREE slides include:

1. a definition of that type of government
 2. TWO advantages and TWO disadvantages of that type of government (on the same slide)
 3. one example of a country or people who've used this form of government (either today or in the past)
- LAST SLIDE: Names of two partners in project

OTHER INSTRUCTIONS:

- You may use pictures where appropriate, either clipart or from the Internet; maximum one per slide
- There must only be ONE background design for all slides

You will be graded on the following:

1. the content of your slides
2. the chronological order of your slides (use MY order)
3. the organization, appropriateness, and the creativity of your slides
4. spelling and grammar
5. your ability to work with your partners by sharing responsibilities and compromising
